Description:

A By-law of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay in the Nunavut Territory, to authorize the Signing Authority pursuant to the Hamlets Act R.S.N.W.T., 1988 c. H-1 s. 44(1)(a) and s. 141 (1)(b).

By-Law

AS the Council of the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay deems it to be in the best interest to have the efficiency of the Administration at the best performance as possible to deal with Payroll and Accounts Payable.

AND WHEREAS the Mayor and the SAO are not always in town to sign the required documents.

NOW, THEREFORE THE HAMLET COUNCIL OF CAMBRIDGE BAY, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

1. **COUNCIL** - The Mayor, Deputy Mayor and another Councillor as appointed by motion shall have signing authority.
2. **ADMINISTRATION** - The SAO and any two Managers as appointed by motion shall have signing authority.
3. Two signatories must sign each cheque – one from council and one from administration.
4. By-Law # 196– Signing Authority is hereby repealed.
