



# Hamlet of Cambridge Bay By-Laws

## Description

A By-law of the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay in the Northwest Territories to prohibit and regulate the discharge of firearms, pursuant to the provisions of the Hamlets Act, S.N.W.T., 1987 (1), c.17, s. 124.

## By-Law

Now, therefore, the council of the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

### 1. Short Title

This by-law may be cited as the *Firearms By-Law*.

### 2. Interpretation

In this By-law:

- a) "Council" means the Council of the Hamlet;
- b) "Firearm" includes gun, rifle, shotgun, pistol, and other barreled weapon;
- c) "Hamlet" means the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay in the Northwest Territories;
- d) "Officer" means a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police or a By-law Officer appointed by By-law; and
- e) "Ticket" means a ticket issued by an Officer pursuant to the provisions of the Summary Conviction Procedures Act.

### 3. Prohibition

No person shall carry on his person, in or on a vehicle, including an all-terrain vehicle, a loaded firearm, except as provided in section 4.

**4. Regulation**

- (1) Subject to subsection (2), no person shall discharge a firearm within one kilometre of human habitation.
- (2) Any person discharging a firearm to destroy an animal, as provided under section 10 of the Dog Act, shall take reasonable care to avoid causing injury or damage to any person or property.
- (3) Any Officer may discharge a firearm during the normal course of their duties.

**5. Offences and Penalties**

- (1) Every person who violates any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is liable, on summary conviction, to a fine of not less than \$50 and not more than \$200.00 or, in default of payment of the fine, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding 30 days.
- (2) A person charged, by means of a ticket, with an offence under this by-law, may, in lieu of appearing in answer to the summons contained in the ticket, pay to the Hamlet the fixed penalty of \$50.00.
