Description

A By-law of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay in the Nunavut Territory to permit the Hamlet to enter into an agreement to maintain and transfer ownership of Public Works and Services assets in the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay pursuant to the Hamlets Act, R.S.N.W.T., 1988, c. H-1 section 130.1(1)

By-Law

WHEREAS the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay agrees to enter into a Community Transfer Agreement with the Government of Nunavut, Department of Public Works and Services;

Now Therefore the Council of the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay in a duly assembled meeting enacts as follows:

1. **Short Title**

This By-law may be cited as the *Community Public Works and Services By-Law*.

2. **Interpretation**

In this By-law:

- a) "Agreement" means the agreement titled "Community Transfer Initiative Memorandum of Understanding" between the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay and the Government of Nunavut attached as Schedule "A" and hereto forming part of this By-law;
- b) "Council" means the Council of the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay;
- c) "GN" means the Government of Nunavut;
- d) "Mayor" means the Mayor of the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay;
- e) "SAO" means the Senior Administrative Officer of the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay

3. **Agreement**

The Mayor and the SAO are hereby authorized by the Council to enter into the agreement with the GN Minister of Public Works and Services and the GN Minister for Community Government and Transportation to deliver Public Works and Services programs in the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay.
