



# Hamlet of Cambridge Bay By-Laws

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## Description

A BY-LAW OF THE Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay in Nunavut to provide for the regulation and licensing of lotteries pursuant to the Lotteries Act R.S.N.W.T., 1988 Chapter L-11 and the Hamlets Act, R.S.N.W.T. Chapter H-1, Section 169(a).

## By-Law

Whereas, the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay has acquired the authority to regulate and license lottery schemes under the Cambridge Bay Lottery Regulations 1996 pursuant to Section 4(b) of the Lotteries Act, and

Whereas, the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay under the authority of the Hamlets Act R.S.N.W.T. 1988, Chapter H-1, Section 169 (a) may provide for the establishment, levy and collection of charges for services provided by the municipal corporation including the issuing of licenses and permits,

Now therefore, the Council of Cambridge Bay, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

1. **Short Title**

This by-law may be cited as the Lotteries By-Law.

2. **Interpretation**

No Person, firm, partnership, company or society shall operate a lottery within the Hamlet unless a Hamlet of Cambridge Bay Lottery License has been obtained pursuant to the Lotteries By-Law.

3. An application form for a license shall be submitted AT LEAST ONE MONTH IN ADVANCE of the scheduled event. If this has not been done the Senior Administrative Officer has the authority to approve this date for another organization within 7 days of the missed application. The application form as set out in Schedule A, shall include the following:

- a) An application setting out the details of the lottery;
- b) A declaration stating a person operating a lottery has not been convicted of an Act or its regulations relating to the operation of a licensed premise where an offence under the Lotteries Act R.S.N.W.T., the Criminal Code Part VII, the Liquor lottery

- is conducted or, any other Act of the Territories or an Act of Canada, a province or the Yukon Territory, or a regulation made under these Acts, that demonstrates it is not in the public interest for that person to conduct a lottery scheme;
- c) A fee as prescribed in Schedule B;
  - d) The fees prescribed for a series of bingo lotteries with games which carry over jackpot amounts, only the amount of the evening jackpot shall be used to calculate the total value of prizes in Schedule B.
  - e) If in the event, the applicant has previously received a license from the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay, the financial statements of the previous lottery must be attached to the application if such record has not already been submitted.
4. Upon being satisfied that an applicant is in compliance with this By-Law and that the application is in order, the S.A.O. shall issue a lottery license as set out in Schedule C of this By-Law.
  5. The Senior Administrative Officer may revoke the Lottery License issued under this By-Law where He/She is satisfied that:
    - a) The license was issued in error whether due to misrepresentation or otherwise.
    - b) The Licensee has breached the conditions of the License;
    - c) The Licensee has violated the provisions of the By-Law, or the applicable statutes or regulations.
  6. Council may, by resolution, establish guidelines to assist with the administration of this By-Law. These guidelines shall become additional terms or restrictions in addition to those noted in the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay Lotteries By-Law.
  7. Every person who contravenes any provision of the By-Law is guilty of an offence and is liable upon summary conviction to:
    - a) for the first offence, to a fine not exceeding Five Hundred (500.00) dollars, and
    - b) for each subsequent offence, to a fine not exceeding Two Thousand (2,000.00) dollars.

## **PART II**

1. All license fees received during each fiscal year, shall be distributed as follows:
  - a) First \$6000.00 to the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay to offset costs incurred by the Hamlet to administer this By-Law;



**Schedule "B"**  
**FEES**

Bingo Lottery Licenses

1. The following license fees are payable for a single event bingo lottery or each lottery of a series of bingo lotteries:
  - a) for prizes of:
    - i) "half the house" bingo: **\$10 for that game**
    - ii) \$1,250 or less for total of all game prizes: **\$50**
    - iii) \$1,251 or greater for total of all game prizes: **4% of the total value of the prizes.**
  
2. The license fee payable for each Nevada ticket lottery, whether a single event lottery or one of a series of lotteries, that is held during a bingo or casino lottery is: **\$50**
  
3. The fee payable for booth license for a series of Nevada ticket lotteries
  - i) where the booth license is for a period of six months is: **\$2,500**
  - ii) where the booth license is for a period of less than six months: **\$50/day of operation.**
  
4. Casino Lottery Licenses  

The license fee payable for each table or wheel game run during a casino lottery is: **\$50/table.**
  
5. Raffle Lottery Licenses  

The license fee payable for a raffle, whether a Nevada Ticket Lottery Licenses single or multiple draw raffle, where the total value of the prizes offered is

  - a) \$1,250 or less is: **\$50**
  - b) greater than \$1,250 is: **4% of the total value of the prizes, or estimated value of prizes.**
  
6. License Amendment  

The fee payable for amending of a license is: **\$10**
