### Fiddlers Colin and Gustin Adjun

Colin Adjun is a home grown self-taught fiddler from Kugluktuk. Colin taught himself how to play the fiddle by ear and through listening to tunes on the radio. Colin was also taught by his uncles John Kuneyuna and Charlie Avakana. Colin has been playing his fiddle for almost 50 years. He has 3 recordings and many songs about the Arctic to his credit. He first started fiddling when he was 9 years old while living on Reid Island.

Colin interprets old favourites as well as writing his own compositions with the skill of a master. Whenever he plays, it's not long before the dance floor fills up! This visit will be no exception.

During the day, Colin is a Wildlife Officer in Kugluktuk with the Government of Nunavut. Besides making the strings of his fiddle sing, Colin is comfortable with the guitar, piano, banjo, accordion and mandolin.

Get set to jig away the night and come out and enjoy Colin Adjun and his 12 year old son Gustin play on Friday and Saturday night at Kullik School.

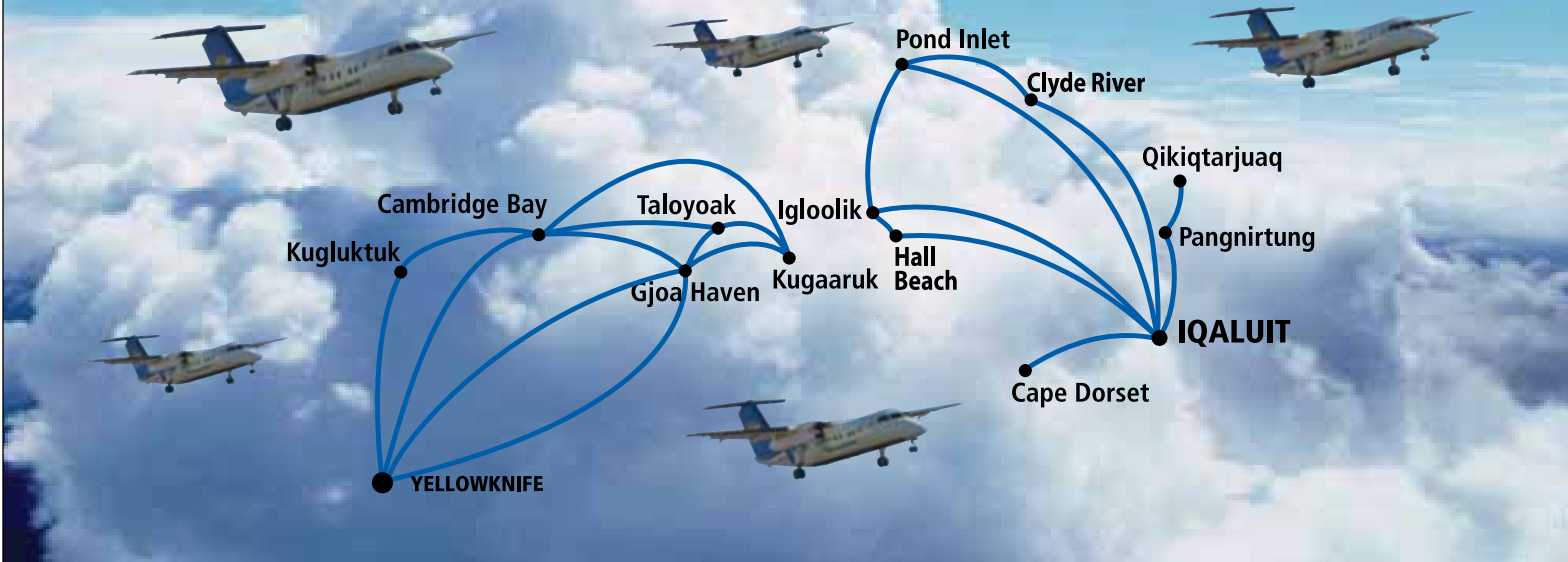
