## Description

A By-law of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay in the Nunavut Territories to provide for the Disposal of Personal Property of the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay pursuant to the provisions of the Hamlets Act, R.S.N.W.T., 1987 (1) c.17, s.132 (1,2,3,4).

## By-Law

Council of the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay, in a regular duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as the April 2000 Property Disposal By-law.
2. In this By-law;
  - a) “Hamlet” means the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay and the area within it’s Municipal Boundary
  - b) “Council” means the Council of the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay
  - c) “Pick-up Trucks” means the two 1987 Suzuki’s and 1988 Ford Trucks

### 3. **Articles for Disposal**

The Hamlet will offer the following articles for Public Tender:

- 2 – 1987 Samurai Suzuki’s, the Wellness Centre and Administration vehicles #’s H-9618 and H-9619 that are located at Hamlet of Cambridge Bay office.
- 1988 Ford Truck, Recreation Service’s truck #H-9724 that is located at the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay office.

### 4. **Terms of Sale**
