5. Around the Table

CAO Marla Limousin: "I look forward to working with you all. There's a lot of excitement in terms of the projects we are doing. There will be a full information session on all of the aspects of the Municipality and its activities as you can see in the Proposed Training Schedule in your package. "

Mayor Pamela Gross: "I'd like to welcome Genevieve Lafrance to council. This is one of her first meetings with us, she was recently hired as the Executive Coordinator. Her position is arranging council meetings, getting in touch with everyone regarding meetings, sending agendas, booking travel and coordinating needs that are outside of council.

I'd also like to welcome Wiz Mohammed. We look forward to working with you on the administrative side. We look forward to working with all of the large projects in the works and look forward to an update in our training sessions."

Anthony Otokiak, observer: "We are thinking of the slippery roads. It's good to see that the roads are not very slippery anymore, thanks to the staff that take care of the roads. I think we need to see a new swimming pool. Our swimming pool is very old and seems like it is about to collapse."

Mayor Pamela Gross: "One of our hopes is that we will be able to have a new facility in the coming years, which we are planning to be a multi-plex. It has been a key hope for a long time and I think we're getting closer to starting to build that facility. The design for the arena is being worked on as we speak and should be ready early this year. We are excited for that. Thanks for your



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suggestions and being here. I appreciate what you have to say and will work on improving those roads and swimming pool in the near future."

Councillor Wilfred Wilcox: "I am looking forward to working with everybody. It is exciting, lots of things have been and are going on in our community."

Councillor Derek Elias: "I want to thank everybody. I look forward to working with everyone for the next four years to do the best for our community and to make sure that we do the best that we can for our residents of our community and making sure that we're held accountable for our actions with the Hamlet Council as a whole. I have a question for you, Madam Mayor, when will we be seeing the minutes from the last meeting?"

Councillor Savanna Moore: "I look forward to working with you all and making decisions on behalf of the residents of Cambridge Bay."

Mayor Pamela Gross: "I'd like to thank everyone for being here and for running to represent our community. I had one question that came up to me in regards to snow removal and snow removal companies. Sometimes the companies that are in charge of clearing snow pack it down or don't run it to areas where town usually has the snow removal dumped, which causes some issues in Spring time for some of the residents. Is there a way that we can work to change that business?

Wiz Mohammed: "We have just been meeting on this and are going to send an e-mail to all the people that are moving snow in our community regarding that issue. We can expect that out by the end of the week."



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Councillor Derek Elias: "In terms of that topic, do we currently have dedicated snow removal areas where we dump snow?"

CAO Marla Limousin: "Yes we do. Wiz, please send Councillors the maps showing the snow removal designated storage points."

Mayor Pamela Gross: "Another issue that was brought to my attention was reviewing By Laws for the age permitting for Side by Sides. There was a recent accident in one of our communities which was very unfortunate and sad. It was brought to my attention to inquire about that. The age limit for driving those types of side by sides."

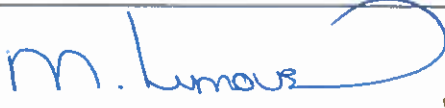
