9. Administrative Report

CAO Limousin presented her administrative update. The Municipality has hired Zachary Cziranka-Crooks as the new Recreational Leader. A local woman had applied to his position but was not qualified for the job. The Municipality plans on finding Trainee money to hire her to work in that department.

The Municipality of Cambridge Bay will be opening Nunavut's first Paint Ball Course from recommendation from the Mayor's Youth Advisory Council. The Paint Ball Course will be opening in Mid-August for all ages. The services will be free for kids during the day through programs and will be a Pay to Play for all ages during the evening. Old pieces of equipment and sea cans will be used in the field, along with a concession to purchase paint balls, guns and other equipment needed to play.

Equipment for new Playgrounds have been ordered and will be installed this year. There are some new ideas for the playgrounds such as garbage cans and benches.

The Art Studio will be opening on September 14th.

We are starting a pilot project to put Polymer to test and maintain the dust on the roads.

10. Around the Table

Councillor Candice Pedersen: "The only thing that I have to ask is when Barrie will be sworn in. I understand that he is in quarantine right now."

Councillor Derek Elias: "I would like to know how our current employees at the Municipality can get training to become more advanced into their careers or if they can job shadow to get into different departments. Just making sure that Hamlet employees are getting the best training possible that they can if they want an advancement within a Hamlet organization."

CAO Marla Limousin: "We deal a lot with the Municipal Training Organization. People who take the programs take different levels and get certificates. Employees from the Department of Healthy Living have gone through the College to upgrade in their career in terms of counselling. They



had an eight week program brought to them that was a specialized program. In terms of service staff, we brought forward to help with computer application and helping with excel and websites as our project management. We are weak in our maintenance and the Arena. We don't have a generation of training for that, the Recreation Project does not exist right now. In the Collective Agreement and the Management Agreement, if people want to go out on Educational Leave or taking courses online than that money is available for them."

Councillor Derek Elias: "I just wanted our Employees to know that the Hamlet has their back if they are interested in taking Education Leave or if they would like to take training."

CAO Marla Limousin: "What happens in the beginning of the year is MTO asks us what kind of programs we want, we send that out to our staff and managers for feedback. We've had people from the Garbage Truck want to be in Recreation or people from the Water Truck looked at Planning and Lands kind of work. They were able to do online courses for that. We can probably promote it more within our staff. We don't have the training dollars to support the whole thing but it's easy to get. Alice wants more conflict resolution courses and the understanding of NEBS. We were trying to get some of our staff to do a Management Training."
